At the Future Medicine Science Match 2020, you get the chance to introduce yourself (and your project) to the international congress community.

If your idea is selected, you can convince the audience of your idea with a short video. In three categories, six talents each will also have the opportunity to present their work live to the science community and decision-makers at the Science Match Digital Edition on 7 November 2020. Five of the talents will be chosen by a top-class science jury; the sixth will be voted by audience.

- The submitting applicant is at least 18 years old.
- The idea will be pitched in a 3-minute video (in English).
- The applicant can only submit one project, either alone or as a team.
- By submitting the application, the applicant guarantees to be the owner of all rights necessary for the project.
- The applicant confirms that he or she can be available at the time of the event (digital or present at the Berlin Tagesspiegel Studio).
